Col^d Burg^r will m^e R. hath no^t ord^r to let any of these Orders committed
to his care and charge for the securing of this County: sent out for the
Supply of Another, but considering of his last ord^r he hopes it may
not be thought amiss, knowing also they are Employed for that purpose
your ~~self~~ intend^d them. It is Considered that with y^r ~~self~~ present
a publick Post be appointed in this exigent of affaires, and that we may
not have upon such emergent occasions a messenger to fetch. For good
