and purpose would give them a meeting in Anne Arund
County whither (if they consented) Jacob Young was to
accompany them downe and apply himself to Col^l
W^m Burg^o who should be required immediately to give
notice of their arrivall to his L^{ty} and his Council with
all expedition possible And that the said Indians should
be assured of a safe Conduct backward and forward,
Which result of his L^{ty} and Council was accordingly drawne
up into an ord. and transmitt^d to Col^l W^m for conveyanc:
to Jacob Young for his Instructions. viz

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By the Lord Prop^r & Council

Whereas his L^{ty} is credibly informed that the Tinniquo
Indians intend to march downe with their Troop: about
the month of July or Aug: next but upon what Design:
is not known. And being Desirous to come to a right
understanding with the said Indians hereby to remove (if
possible) all fear and Jealousie from the Inhabitants of
this Province by reason of any Inroad or Incursions that
may otherwise be made by the said Indians (in their March)
upon the frontire plantations, His L^{ty} by and with the
advice and Consent of his Council willing to treat with
the said Indians and to renew the Articles of peace last
made with them hath Ordered.

That Jacob Young of Cecil County (understanding the language spoken
by the said Indians) be Authorized and Empowered and he is hereby
Authorized and Empow^rd (at what time he shall be certainly informed
that the said Indians may upon their March) to ly: in wait at or
neere the house of M^r Anthony Dimondier or of where in their
road, and indav^r to speak: with the said Indians, and lett them
know that his L^{ty} the Lord Prop^r of this Province is very
Desirous to see and speak: with some of their greate men, And
