and provided, to the great trouble and disquiet of others
the good People Inhabitants of this Province, the
promptory Declaring that he will so do: not
withstanding several Remonitions of Com: to y^e
contrary and the severe checks and threats of com:
plaint from others if he continued so. Doing all
which is of dangerous consequence: wherefore to
prevent y^e same for y^e future. — Ordered.

That the Comiss^{rs} of the said County Court do: forthwith
upon Receipt hereof in the name of R^{ts} Hon^{ble} J^{ts} of the Prov^{ts}
Summon before them y^e said Thomas Jones, and him strictly
examine and make due inquiry into the truth of such his
pretenses, and if upon Examination and such inquiry made
as aforesaid it shall appear that the said Jones hath accordingly
acted as is alleged against him — or otherwise upon good
grounds that y^e Jones hath illegally traded and dealt with
any Indian contrary to Act of Assembly as by y^e said Com:
plaint hath been set forth, then they are to bind the said
Jones to his good behavior taking good security for y^e
same and for his appearance at y^e next Prov^{ts} Court
further to answer the premises. In Exact Acc^{ts} whereof
the J^{ts} Commiss^{rs} under their hands or attested by their Clerk
are to transmit to his Ex^{ty} and Council with all convenient
speed.
