to publish pronounce and Declare the said Commission to be void null
and vacated to all intents and purposes strictly charging & commanding
the said Hawkins to take due Cognizance hereof and not to act any
further by virtue or under pretence of the same as he will answer
the contrary at his perill Dated the fifth Day of October in the
fifth year of the Dominion of the Rth Hon^{ble} Charles C^{le} Blompp
