And whereupon the said Mary Townsend by William Harris her Attorney complaineth and saith that the said Richard Lee late of this County decd. did in his life time owe and was indebted unto the said Mary the summe of five hundred pounds of tobacco in cash and although the said Mary have often demanded the said summe of five hundred pounds of tobacco in the life time of the said Richard and since the Death of Michael Miller Administrator of all goods and Chattels, which hath & find and still doth & full to make payment to the said Mary so that she saith that she is damaged and hath Damages to the value of Eight hundred pounds of tobacco and thereupon she bringeth this suit Harris vs [unclear]

Both parties viz. Michael Miller and Sarah Townsend being heard and passed thereupon the following order viz
The Council held at St. Marks the 26th Day of April 1681:
In a certain matter of Controversy between Michael Miller and Sarah Townsend both of Kent County this Day moved to the [unclear] Council and
