did make several Surveys and took up Lands for several the Inhabit-
ants of this Province in the said County, the Certificates whereof (for that
the Land Office since the late Revolution has been shut up) have not been
returned thither, but remain still in the Custody of your Petitioner ready
to be delivered as your Honours shall direct, which he humbly prays may
be done, and Entries thereof made upon Record for the Preservation and
Security of the Persons therein interested and concerned, if so it shall seem
meet to your Honours Your Petitioner hath well behaved himself in
the said Office to the Satisfaction of the whole County, and Others by whom
he was employed, and hath been dutifull and obedient to the Government
as he promises and assures your Honours he shall still continue, &
prays that if the Surveyors Office shall be thought necessary to be put
in Practice, Your Petitioner may be continued in his Station, or other-
wise that he may be licensed by your Honours to officiate the s. Office
between the Inhabitants for the laying out and ascertaining the bounds
of their respective Lands already taken up as shall be desired by them
upon such terms and for such fees as the Law directs and appoints
