By the Governor and Council October 29th 1692

Ordered that Major Ninion Beal (commander in chief under his Excellency the Captain Generall) of all their Majestys forces or Militia of Horse and Foot in Calvert County do forthwith call in and take into his custody and possession all & singular the publick arms belonging to both horse & foot in the said County the same to have well fixed Cleaned & Repaired and again delivered into such hands as he shall think fit and best for their Majestys Service upon all Occasions where of he is to keep a true and exact Acco^t to be rendered to his Exc^{cy} with all convenient speed
