good Behaviour (whereof he hath already made a
Breach & for his appearance at the next provin-
cial Court to answer what shall then & thereupon
the Majestys Behalf be objected against him &
in case the said Toulas shall deny or refuse to give
such Bond & Security as aforesaid then the said
Bigger is to take him into custody until he shall
redeem
