 for himself in the sum of Two hundred Pounds Sterling  
 & his two Security in the sum of Two hundred & Fifty pounds  
 Sterling each for his appearance at the next Provincial Court  
 to answer the same & in the mean time to be of Good & Sob  
 Behaviour

Then came Doctor Simon Holton and acknowledged  
 himself to be owing & indebted unto our Sovereign Lord the  
 King in the sum of Two hundred Pounds Sterling that he  
 the said Holton should be & personally appear at the next  
 Provincial Court as Evidence for the King against the afo  
 rnamed Thomas Johnson

Ordered that William Gilly who officiated the place  
 of Sec<sup>y</sup> keep the present Council be allowed for his trou  
 ble the sum of One hundred pounds of Tobacco at the next  
 laying of the Levy
