

Seal the Board together with Quasapetagh an Indian
Commonly known & Called by the Name of the Anacostin King
The Articles of Peace are read unto them
They are asked if they will acknowledge those Articles & same
by them who do jointly make Annexed that they are ready to
Stand & abide by the same

Then it is demanded that they Give an Account of the per-
son or persons who committed the late murder in Charles County
being Justly Suspected to be Indians under their protection
and they make Answer they are Ignorant who are the per-
sons concerned

Positive Demand is made by the Board that Quasapetagh
an Indian now present commonly known & called by the
Name of the Anacostin King be surrendered up to receive a
speedy trial at Charles County Court House having sufficient
Circumstances to suspect the said Quasapetagh to be Con-
cerned in the aforementioned Murder who after a long Con-
sultation about the same had they Consent to deliver up the said
Quasapetagh otherwise called the Anacostin King as a Prisoner
pursuant to the aforementioned Articles of Peace

Ordered that his Mallettis be accordingly drawn to be
kept in the Custody of the Sheriff of Charles County until he
be hence delivered by Due Course of Law the which accordingly
is issued in these following Wentes vix

Mr Thomas Lawrence Board President together with
the rest of their Majestys Council of Maryland to all & com-
munity their high Sheriff of Charles County Greeting You
have herewith undersafe & secure Conduct sent you the Body
of Quasapetagh an Indian commonly known & called
by the Name of the Anacostin King this day surrendered up
unto us a Prisoner by the Sheriff of Piscatawaye Great men
upon our Demand suspected to be concerned in a most Bloody
and horrid Murder committed in & upon the Body of One James
a Native Indian within your County which said Prisoner
