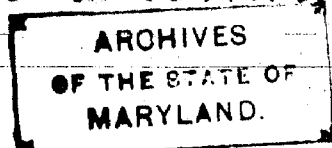


them with power to punish the same according to the Laws of England or this Province pursuant to the aforementioned Articles of Peace which Commission to remain to be enforced during pleasure.

Upon Representation of some Gentlemen of the Council to the honorable the President that there is an Apparent & absolute Necessity for the immediate appointing & electing a new Sheriff in Compliance to the Act of Assembly of this Province for want of which it being alleged that great Complaints are likely to be made & offered from all parts of the Province Resolved & Ordered thereupon that the Council Meet & sit upon the day & place last aforementioned in Order to Elect a Sheriff accordingly
