

For Somerset County M<sup>r</sup> Ephraim Wilson  
 Mr William Parker of Salterton County being represented by  
 several of the Inhabitants thereof to be a fit person for Sheriff  
 of the said County was for some time objected against by the  
 Board so that he the said Parker was by an Order of this  
 Board of the 29<sup>th</sup> of June last just required to be and appear  
 at the next General Court having been concerned together  
 with several others of the Commissioners of that County in in  
 signing a pretended Act of Assembly then produced in  
 Council; however it was voted that the said Parker be Committed  
 to the service of the said County for the ensuing Year upon  
 Acknowledgment of his Offence & making Submission  
 before this Board the which he accordingly performed express  
 ing himself sorry for the same

Ordered that Commissioners be forthwith prepared to pass  
 the Board seal to nominate the several forenamed persons  
 Sheriffs within the several & respective Counties according  
 to appointment which said Commissioners they are to re-  
 main at the next County Court to be held in the Month  
 of August at which time the Commissioners are hereby  
 charged to take Bond with Two sufficient securities for  
 the due Execution of their said Places the Sher<sup>r</sup>. of St  
 Marys, Salterton, Anson, Answell, Talbot & Somerset giving  
 Bond to the sum of three hundred thousand pounds of  
 Tobacco & the Sheriff for the rest of the Counties in the  
 sum of Two hundred thousand pounds of Tobacco

Ordered that the Sheriff receive deliver as much  
 Powder and Ball as is represented by Col<sup>t</sup> Richard<sup>s</sup> Gott  
 to him to keep ready and wanting in Rochester  
 and Somers<sup>t</sup> for the defence & security of those  
 parts

Ordered that Captain John Addison of Charles Town  
 & Captain Thomas Holliday of Salterton County have hereby
