I, A. B. do^r swear that I will be true & faithful
to King William and Queen Mary their heirs & successors: and
will have & hold Justices all and every of them in to and over
this their Province of Maryland & the Islands thereto belonging &
I will at all times do^r and be ready to the utmost of my power and to
will ever except nor execute any place office or imployement within
the said Province any way concerning or relating to the Government
of the said Province from any person or Authority, but by command
or under a warrant Authority derived or to be derived from him &
to him from their Maj: his Heirs & Successors their
place & welfare of the People of this Province I will ever procure
as far as I can, will aid and assist the administering & execution
of Justice in all things to my power, to none will I denye Right &
conferre favour or affection, I will do my best skill and according
to my heart & conscience give good & faithfully Council to their Maj:
his Heirs & Successors and to their Gov:rnor or Comandor
in Chief for the time being, when thereto I shall be called, I
will apper & cert all Matters committed or referred unto me, or
which shall be Advised or debated publicly in Council, and faithfully
declare my mind & opinion thereon, according to my heart & conscience

And if any of the said Justices or Councils shall touch any of the
privy Councils of the Province I will not reveal the same but
him for touched or concerned, but will keep the same secret, until
such time as by the command of their Maj: his or their Gov:rnor or
in Chief for him, for the time being publication shall be made where
I will also be a Councillor and as a Justice by Council for cause
of the peace of this Province do: quall Right unto the King
