said Province & Territory of Maryland, to have, hold, exercize &
enjoy the Office & place of Command: in Chiefe of our said Province
and Territory of Maryland for & during our pleasure, with all the
rights, priviledges, profits & advantages to the same belonging and all
appertaining in case of the death of the said Cap: Francis Nichollson
and absence of the said Col: & Liont. Col: Nichollson as afores: with full power
& authority to execute & perform all & singular the powers & directions
contained in our said Commission to the said Col: & Liont. Col: Nichollson & such
instructions as we have already or shall hereafter from time to
time send to him. And we hereby command all & singular our & the
officers, Ministers & loving Subjects of our said Province & Territory
and all others whom it may concern to take due Notice hereof & to
give him ready obedience accordingly, given at our Court at Kingstoun
the third day of March 1692: in the fourth year of our Reigne.
