Mr Praycroft Motion
about Mr Lyons

Mr John Praycroft, by Mr Wm Dent his Counsel being admitted,
humbly complains to the Board for Relief against Mr Philip
Lyons, against whom he had lately recovered in the Provincials &
Court a Judgment for 400^l & Costs of Suits, and thereupon
served him with an Execution for the same, upon which he was
taken into Custody of the Sheriff of the County of Middlesex, from whence
he hath been illegally discharged upon a Supersedeas & Writ of Error
by him surreptitiously obtained, with a design to defraud & protract to
the making Satisfaction for the Debt & Costs aforesaid, And the said
Praycroft having (upon former application to this Board) favourably
obtained an Order of the 25th of August last for the said Lyons to
file his Error against the said Judgment within ten days after the
date of the said Order, and peremptorily to come to a hearing and
arguing of the same here at the beginning of the Assembly: The said
Lyons having in no wise complied therewith, the said Praycroft humbly
prays the same may be dismissed this Board, and the said Lyons again
remanded into custody until he have fully satisfied & discharged the
said Judgment.
