 trading on the Eastern Shore to repair to such place as the
 Collector or Collectors there shall Order & appoint for their most
 convenient Clearing & sayling as directed, And upon their Clearing
 that the severall Collectors take Security of the said Masters for
 their sayling to their Voyages at point Comfort, of which the
 Collectors are to give present Notice to all Masters & Commanders of
 Ships, and they and all others concerned to conforme therunto accordingly.
