 Number Ninety) be paid each Man the Sum^{me} of Nine pounds for three
 thousand pounds of Tobacco, and their said Command^{er} the Sum^{me} of fifty
 pounds for or five thousand pounds of Tobacco to be paid out of the
 Impos^t Money of 4^{per} cent Gall, being in part of Satisfaction for what is due
