 in their Colony of Virginia, and at present there being no other person, upon
 this place commissionate to be Commandour in Chief of this their Province & Dominion,
 Pursuant therfore to their Majesties Commission to me directed (as by advice
 in Council) in their Majesties Names, by this Proclamation, Notifie & make
 knowne the Administration of the Governour, and the Execution of the
 Commission, and the severall Powers and Authorities therein contained (as
 during my absence) or their Majesties pleasure further knowne, to be in the
 the Council of this their Majesties Province & Dominion, and the Hon: our
 Nicholas Grousbury Esq: to preside therein, until my Returne or further
 Orders of all which I doe hereby require & commaund all ~~the~~ their Majesties
 Officers both civill & Military, within this their Dominion, and all other
 persons whatsoever to take Notice & conforme themselves accordingly, as if
 they or any of them will aufer the contrary, at their utmost perills, to
