Thomas Lawrence Representeth unto this Board the Request of
Mr John Lawrence in his duty during the time he officiated as Clerk
of Gallop County Court setting forth his omission as to the Entry of most
of that Courts Proceedings in his time taken, to the great prejudice and
damage of the Suitors wither coming, and that he understood the
said Lawrence was upon going for England, therefore desired that (as the
said County Records were part of the trust reposed in him by their
Maj^{ties} as Secretary and forasmuch as he had rec^d severall Complaints
from the inhabitants of that County in relation to the premises) the
said Lawrence might be called before this Board and caused to give
Security for his speedy completing the said County Records together
with the Land Office Records, and that the same might by the
said Lawrence be finished & delivered up before he goes for England.
And the said Thomas further set forth that whereas the said
Lawrence had by a Commission from the late Gov^{rn} officiated as Notary
Publick, whereby not only the Rights of his Office had been Encroached
upon but likewise his Maj^{ties} Patent apparently infringed; prays that
this Board would please to Order him to desist for the future from
the Execution of any Matter relating to the said Office, that
