 day together with Articles of impeachment against

 which Articles the Governor & Council of Maryland
 Acquaint them. So they had committed & confined
 fr^r Thomas Lawrence and had dismissed him from the
 being of the Council & Judge of the Provincial Court.
 There appearing to the Committee no ground for such
 Proceedings although the allegations contained in the
 said Articles were true, but that the Proceedings
 of the Governor & Council in this Matter are illegal
 and arbitrary; Their Maj^s Part of Opinion that the
 Governor & Council of Maryland be directed to give
 fr^r Thomas Lawrence a copy of the Articles transmitted
 against him, and that he return his Answer unto
 them, to the End their Maj^s pleasure therupon may
 be known, and that in the meantime fr^r Thomas &
 Lawrence be set at liberty and be restored to his places
 of Governor & Judge of the Provincial Court, and that
 he receive no molestation or disturbance in the ex-
 ercise of his Office of Secretary of Maryland, according
 to his Maj^s former Order in Council of the 2^d of
 March last and that permission be given in Maryland
 to examine all Persons that shall give Evidence in this
