

Matters without any hindrance or discountenance to
such persons as Mr Thomas Lawrence shall desire to be
examined on his behalf.

Mr Hall in Council approved of the same and is this
day to be so done as it is therein ordered accordingly
that the Governor & Council of Maryland do give
Mr Lawrence a copy of the Articles transmitted against
him, and that he forthwith returns to his said Lord his
Answer in writing to the said Articles, to the Duke
his Highness's pleasure thereupon may be known. And that
in the mean time the said Mr Thomas Lawrence be left
at liberty, and be restored to his place of Justice
and Judge of the Provinciaall Court in Maryland and
that he receive no molestation or disturbance in the
enjoyment of his Office of Justice of that Province,
according to his Highness's Order in Council of the second
of March last. And that permission be given in Maryland
to examine all persons that shall give evidence in this
Matter without any hindrance or discountenance to such
persons as the said Mr Thomas Lawrence shall desire to be
examined on his behalf.
