 above bound Robert King is Nominat: & appoint: Navall
 Officer for the County of Somerset in the Province aforesaid
 Now if the above bound Robert King performe & discharge the Dutys
 imposed in time and Order a just & true Account of all Monys, Taxes
 or other Duties by him Collected & Received or to be Collected & Received
 as Navall Officer to such person or persons qualifyed to Demand the
 same when Required, then the above Obligation to be Void: the
 contrary to stand in full force & Virtue.
