Sheriff of the Court of Admiralty ORDERED that a Court of Admiralty Commission be prepared for ~~the purpose~~ a Prize Ship taken by Captain Hurler from the French, constituting & appointing Mr John Watson, Mr John Low, Mr Sam. Watkins, Cap. Edward G. G. G. & Mr Thomas Vaughan Comissioners & Justices for the said End & purpose.

Warrant issued to the Sheriff of the County for the immediate apprehending & bringing before this Board Thomas Johnson of the said County to answer to such Things as our Pleas & Objections shall be objected against him.

Also Johnson Comitted to the Custody of the Sheriff

Johnson & appeared at the Board the aforesaid Thomas Johnson in the Custody of the said Sheriff and was read unto him a Deposition sworn to by Doctor Symon Wotton relating to rebellious & Irreasonable Words spoken and uttered by the aforesaid Johnson - ORDERED therefore as it is here by Ordered that the said Johnson still remain in the Custody of the Sheriff, until he give good & sufficient Security or Enter into Recognizance himself in the Sum of Five hundred Pounds Sterling, and two Security in the Sum of Two hundred & Fifty Pounds Sterling each for his Appearance at the next Provincial Court to answer the same, & the means here to be of good behaviour.
