 their protection, and they make answer they are ignorant
 who are the parties concerned.

The Anacostin

Positive Demand is made by the Board that Quasaptagh
 an Indian now prisoner, commonly known and called by
 the name of the Anacostin King be surrendered up to
 receive a speedy Tryall at Charles County Court house; &
 having pregnant Circumstances to suspect the said Quasap-
 tagh to be concerned in the aforementioned Murder;
 who after a long Consultation about the same had, they
 consent to deliver up the said Quasaptagh otherwise
 called the Anacostin King as a prisoner, pursuant to the
 aforementioned Articles of peace.
