His Excellency asked the Board which was the usual way of establishing the Kings
 Commission, who made Answer that it was usually done in the Council Chamber, at the
 Provincial Court and Assembly.

When his Excellency was pleased to acquaint the Board what Gentlemen were now
 ordered and appointed to be of their Majesties Council within the said Province, whose
 Names were read unto them as follows, Viz. Sir Thomas Laurence Lord Henry Jones
 Lord George Robotham Lord Nicholas Greenbury Thomas Lench Esq. Lord Charles & A
 Michall. Hutchins Lord David Browne Cap: John Dawson Cap: John Courts Thomas Brooke
 Esq. James Hilsby Esq.

It being late in the Evening, his Excellency thought fit to suspend the swearing of
 the Council until the next Morning and so

Adjourned till to Morrow Morning Seven a Clock.

July 27th 1694.

The Council Met & Late and were present as Yesterday

 recorded & so God's.

The Oaths appointed by Act of Parliament to be taken instead of the Oaths of
 Allegiance & Supremacy were administered in Council unto his Excellency as likewise the
 Oath of Trade & Navigation.

 continue in the Governm. and Command of Maryland well & truly execute and performe
 and cause to be Executed and performed all Matters and Things which by the Statute
