

and to the Hon<sup>ble</sup> their Ma<sup>ties</sup> Council of Maryland.

Pursuant to your Ex<sup>ty</sup> Ord<sup>r</sup> of Reference of the 17<sup>th</sup> day relating to  
 their Ma<sup>ties</sup> Revenue that a true State thereof should be by me returned  
 to your Ex<sup>ty</sup> in Council I do humbly Certify the same within my  
 Collection as follows; That the sume totall of the Duty of the One  
 Shilling and three pence of hoghead on Tobacco Exported out of the  
 District of Potomack from the time of the arrivall of the late  
 Governor Copley to this day amounts to the sume of three  
 thousand twenty three pounds three shillings & eight pence, as  
 my Account thereof ready to produce may appear; the said Duty  
 being also Charged Debt for paym<sup>ts</sup> mad<sup>e</sup> out of the same the  
 sume of two thousand five hundred Ninety seven pounds two shillings  
 and four pence, the Ballance thereof in my hands being five  
 hundred & four pounds, one shilling & four pence; the which  
 Ballance is ready to be answered and paid And I do likewise humbly  
 Certify further to your Ex<sup>ty</sup> that the Duty of four pence of Gallon  
 on all Liquors import<sup>d</sup> & by me Collect<sup>d</sup> within the afores<sup>d</sup> District  
 amounts to the sume of three hundred thirty five pounds as  
 my Account also may Appear And that the paym<sup>ts</sup> out of the said  
 Duty comes to the sume of two hundred twenty one pounds; there still  
 remaining unpaid upon Account that Duty the sume of One hundred &  
 fourty pounds. As to the Fines & Forfeitures due to their Ma<sup>ties</sup>  
 Under my Collection, the same have not been as yet Collect<sup>d</sup>, though  
 some of the same have been returned me; I not having as yet rec<sup>d</sup> any  
 Orders for the disposall thereof and do also Certify to your Ex<sup>ty</sup>  
 that I have Collect<sup>d</sup> in the District of Potomack for their Ma<sup>ties</sup> Use  
 the sume of One hundred Eight pounds Eight shillings & Nine pence  
 the which is still lodged with me.

The Revenue of that District amounts to a greater sume of Money the  
 Certainty of which may appear at such time as your Ex<sup>ty</sup> shall think  
 proper for the whole State of the Revenue of that District to be brought
