 your Ma^{ty} therefore prays yo^r Ex^{ty} and Hono^r to take the said Reasons into your serious
 consideration and Order some person to receive from the Commissioners their Ma^{ty} part
 of the said Goods forthwith that the rest may by the day appointed be exposed
 to sale and your petition proceed in his other Affairs
