Cap^t John Farmer, Cap^t John Payne and severall other Masters being fallen downe wth their Ships unto the Mouth of Potuxant River in Ord^r to clear their Vessells doe humbly move to Saye notwithstanding a former Order of this Board w^{ch} Commands that noe Ships should be cleared after the 13th of this instant Septemb^r: Setting forth their being Stopt by contrary Winds and bad Weather. Order'd thereupon as it is hereby Order'd that Whereas there is noe advice as yet come to this province of the Fleets being gone out of Virginia the sd^d Vessells be cleared notwithstanding the w^{ch} foremenconed Order.

Order'd that George Plater Esq^r their Maj^{ties} Collector and Receiver Generall write to Cap^t Pagon Merch^{ant} in London to provide and send in by the first conveyance in a Man of Warre if one comes these following Armes to the Value of two hundred and fifty pound^s Ster^{ling}: out of the Quarter part of their Maj^{ties} Revenue now Remaining in his hands but y^e he be silent in the doing thereof by Reason the Govern^{ment} have not had time to send at p^{re}sent severall Journalls home w^{ch} are now preparing

Arms as follows Viz^t

Dragoons Armes
and furniture w^{ch}
sent for in

3rd Twenty Dragoons Brides & Saddles.
Gen hand Mortars such as the two Companies at Tangier had sent them when my Lord Dartmouth was there - To inquire of S^r Henry Goodrich or some other officers of the Tower of the price and where they can be had w^{ch} one hundred hand Granadoes fit for these hand Mortars and fuzes w^{ch} proper Wading and directions how to use them.
Half a dozen Instrum^{ts} to try powder with and the rest of the 250 lb^s to be laid out in Granadoes Armes, Viz^t Slunges, Siftes, Sanguins or otherwise filed the best way to keep them from Rust & Ruyonets fuzes for the Base of these fuzes w^{ch} large Cartouch boxes to hold betwixt two or three doz^{ns} of Cartridges, and to send good hatchets.
The Cartouch box to goe upon ^{one} belt and the Hatchet & Baguet in two hangers upon the same belt and pouches to carry the Granadoes in.

It being debated at the Board whether his Exce^{llency} S^r Edmond Andros Comission here produced ought to have taken place there being found palpable contradictions between the sd^d Comission and his Exce^{llency} proclamation and if in case it appear the sd^d S^r Edmond did take upon him this Govern^{ment} illegally whether or noe severall ill consequences may not follow thereon; to w^{ch} his Hono^r: Col^l: Greenberry made Answer that they doe not find any person Agrieved but what they did care in regard to their Maj^{ties} Comission and they believed the sd^d S^r Edmond came wth a legall Comission but if it falls out that they shall be call'd in question for it by the King he will goe home and Aske the Kings pardon - Whereupon his Exce^{llency} does say that he may have leave to goe Aboon as he pleases and that their Maj^{ties} Service in the interim thereby will not suffer here.
