Upon Representation ordered that an Embargo and Stop be put upon all Ships & Vessells bound for Europe until the first day of Novemb^r: next and y^e no such Ships be cleared to Saily by any of their Maj^{ties} Collectors w^{ch}: in this Province before that day and that no such Ships as shall be afterwards cleared until further Order w^{ch}: is supposed will not be till Christmas or after. And that the Fleet be made up in Potuxant River. except the two Ships in Potomock whereof all persons concerned are to take due Notice
