That the <sup>sd</sup> Sr Edmond by Letters Appearing under his hand did Order & transcripts of the Journall of the Councill to be sent him from hence into Virginia as Appears by his Letters to Coll: Greenberry then President.

Governour demand of Major Rob: King ab: taking the Oath of Feal: 49 Whitehall

Major Rob: King Appearing at the Board w<sup>th</sup> his Acc<sup>ts</sup> of Navall Officers for Pocomock District being Appointed & placed in the <sup>sd</sup> Office by the late Governour Copley and continued therein by his Exec<sup>ty</sup> Sr Edmond Andros - His Exec<sup>ty</sup> does demand of the <sup>sd</sup> King whether ever he had taken the Oath of Trade & Navigation who makes answer he never did.

At a Councill held Octob: the 17<sup>th</sup> 94:

Present.

His Exec<sup>ty</sup> the Governour & all the Members of the Hon<sup>ble</sup> Councill.

Gover: demand what money Sr Edmond Andros received from this Governour -

His Exec<sup>ty</sup> demands of the Board what Money his Exec<sup>ty</sup> Sr Edmond Andros Received from this Governour and upon what Acc<sup>ts</sup> Given to w<sup>ch</sup> the Gentlemen of the Board make answer that he had 300<sup>l</sup> Ster: paid him by this Governour the w<sup>ch</sup> was done in Manner following viz:

Whitehall

That his Exec<sup>ty</sup> the last time he came over to this Governour: w<sup>ch</sup> was beginning of May last calling for an Acc<sup>ts</sup> from their Maj<sup>ty</sup> Receiver and Navall Officers of the Revenue belonging to this Governour: w<sup>ch</sup> being produced and perused he finding at that time a certaine bank and fund of Money Remaining in their Maj<sup>ty</sup> Receivers hands did say that he believed the Revenue of this Governour was as large as that of Virginia and therefore hoped that he might be considered for his Services here & Expences disbursed in Undertaking that Journey w<sup>ch</sup> said had been extraordinary and to the hazard of his life proposing that four or five hundred pounds might be Ordered out of the said Revenue. Whereupon five hundred pounds Ster: was ~~Ordered~~ Ordered to be paid him by their Maj<sup>ty</sup> Receiver out of the 15<sup>d</sup> p hoghead

In Acc<sup>ts</sup> of Sr Edmond's expences during his stay in this Governour &c

Then was produced at the Board the two following Acc<sup>ts</sup> of Expences disbursed by his Exec<sup>ty</sup> Sr Edmond Andros at his twice coming over to this place the w<sup>ch</sup> were Sworne to in Councill. and are as follows
