I lately Received a Letter from the Hon<sup>ble</sup> Will<sup>m</sup> Blathwaite Esq<sup>r</sup> Auditor  
Generall of America Dated at Whitchell the 19<sup>th</sup> day of Aprill 1694 whereby  
I am Comanded to render a State of my Acco<sup>t</sup> of their Maj<sup>ties</sup> Revenue by me  
Collected to his Exce<sup>l</sup>: Coll<sup>r</sup>: Francis Nicholson our Governour who is directed by their  
Maj<sup>ties</sup> to return to England the full Acco<sup>t</sup> of their Maj<sup>ties</sup> Revenue co<sup>th</sup> in this Province  
ever since the Revolution and also to State the same here (pursuant to my duty) I  
have rendered to his Exce<sup>l</sup>: an Acco<sup>t</sup> of payments made out of their Maj<sup>ties</sup> Revenue as also  
what hath been by me Collected for their Maj<sup>ties</sup> Use here and doe find a difficulty and  
obstructions in paying that Article of five hundred pounds Ster: paid Go: Exec: <sup>1694</sup>  
when last here His Exce<sup>l</sup>: the Governour being desirous of a further Satisfaction  
from Go: Self then what I can give him upon what Acco<sup>t</sup>: It was paid the Money  
being Comanded here for Supply of Armes and Ammunition pursuant to their  
Maj<sup>ties</sup> Comands besides S<sup>r</sup> Thomas is to be Allowed his Salary as President, I must  
presume to press upon Go: Exec: <sup>1694</sup> for a full and a Satisfactory Answer being  
my self lyable to pay that Money unless Go: Exec: <sup>1694</sup> please to Hono: me co<sup>th</sup> a  
Lyne intimating your right thereto I Begg an Answer by the Bearer Cap<sup>t</sup>: that  
not doubting Go: Exec: <sup>1694</sup> Justice in the Indication of the payment by me made  
or taking effectual Care that no injury thereby is done to

by Commission from his Exce<sup>l</sup>: S<sup>r</sup> Edmond Andros and being Informed since the arrivall  
of his Exce<sup>l</sup>: Coll<sup>r</sup>: Fran<sup>cois</sup> Nicholson that one Doctor Payne of London hath by  
Patent to their Sacred Maj<sup>ties</sup> obtained from his Exce<sup>l</sup>: a Grant of the sd Office so  
far as the Lawes and Constitutions of this Province will permit but that he  
hath no wages as yet qualified himself or any other person according to the sd  
Lawes and Constitutions to receive the sd Grant or Office at the sd Office in Maryland
