Upon View of the Armes and Amunition, at S^t Maries found
In the Governours House One hundred thirty two Musketts Seven teen Bar^{ls}
of powder whole.
Four Barrells opened two of them almost full two other half full.
One Large Barrell halfe full of Musquet Bullets.
One lesser 3 quarters full of small bullets.
In the State House 61 Barrells of powder.

Ordered that the Armes Bullets and Shot be likewise divided and
parcelled out proportionable to the powder, And that on Bar^{ls} of
the S^d powder be lodged in a place onely and that neither the S^d
Armes nor Amunition be medel^d wth or made use of Unless upon case
of Invasion or insurrection w^{ch} God forbid.

Militia Order and
Instructions

The following Orders and Instructions relating to the Regulating
the Militia drawn forth by Order and sign^d & sealed by his Exc^{ty}
were sent to each County of the Province

By his Exc^{ty} the Govern^r & Council^{ls}
Octob^r the 9th 1694.

Ordered that there be three field Officers Appointed in each
County Viz^t A Col^l: Lieutenant Colonel and A Major to be Commis-
-onated by his Exc^{ty} wth power to Appoint and Commission all Officers
under them and Enlist souldiers in such and so many Divisions as they
shall see most proper and convenient. - A Troope to consist of A,
Captain, Lieutenant Colonel, Quarter Master, a Clerk, three
Corporalls, thirty six private Troopers & a Drummer.

A Company of Foot to consist of A, Captain, Lieutenant, Ensigne,
a Clerk, three Serjants, four Corporalls, & two Drumors, & seventy
two private souldiers.

That there be Dragoons Regim^{ts} where they can conveniently each Troope
consist of one Cap^t: one Lieutenant, one Colonel, a Quarter Master,
a Clerk three Serjants and four Corporalls & forty five Troopers
And soe much as it being Assembly time & all Clerks now in Town
are busily employed in writing for the Military Commission cannot
