

Memorandum that whereas Samuel Dyer of the County of Crumwell
 in which his wife die on the 6th day of May last humbled
 to this Board that she the said Susanan was by a certain Decree of
 Council bearing date the 6th of May Anno 1693 rendered incapable
 of having her Oath taken to be good evidence in any Matter
 within this Province and therefore prayed some consideration might
 be had relating thereto whereby the said Order might be set aside
 and she restored as formerly. which was granted her and Order
 accordingly Indorsed upon the backe of her Petition, but the said Pet:
 by Accident being since lost, It was Ordered as follows Viz.

Ordered that An Order of his Exce^{ty} and Council bearing date the Sixth
 day of May Anno 1693 relating to the invalidating the Oath of ~~the said~~

 set aside, dissolved and made void so that by means of any thing in the
 said Order contained she be nowise rendered incapable of having her Oath
 taken in any Court or before any Justice wth in this Province
