Plantations in any other shipps or Vessells whatsoever but in
such shipps or Vessells as do truly and without fraud belong only to the
people of England or Ireland. Dominion of Wales or Town of
Berwick upon Tweed or any of the Built up and belonging to any
of his Majt's Colonies or plantacions as the approprietors and right
Owners thereto And whereof the Master and three fourths of the
Mariners at least are English under the penalty of the Forfieture
and loss of all the Goods & Commodities which shall be imported or
Exported to or from any of the said Colonies or Plantacions in
any other ship or Vessel, & also of the ship or Vessel importing
or Exporting the same: And if any Goods shall be imported or
Exported contrary thereto, you are to make Seize therof as
also of the ship or Vessel and prosecute the same as in the said
Act is directed.

8. Whereas by the aforesd Act of Trade made in the 15th year
of his said Majt's Reign & his said Majt's Proclamation pursuant
thereto of the 24th of Novemb. in the 25th year of his Reign &
no Commodities of the growth, production or Manufacture of
Europ: (other than such as are herein excepted) are to be import'd
into Maryland or any other of his Majt's Colonies or Plantacions, but
what shall be bona fide and without fraud laden on ship in England
Wales or Berwick and in ships duly qualified as ther: is direct'd;
you are so to use your utmost Endeavours for the due obseruance of
the said Act. And if contrary thereto any ship or Vessel shall
import any Commodities of the Growth, production or Manufacture
of Europ: but what are excepted as aforesd of which due proof
shall not be made that the same were ship or laden in some
Port of England, Wales or Berwick, such ship or Vessel &
goods are Forfieted, And you are to Seize & prosecute the same
accordingly.
