says, he was so sick at that time, that he was not able to travel
therefore hopes his Ex^{ty} & the Hon^{ble} Board would not Censure
him in a Matter no ways occasioned by his own Neglect, the
Hon^{ble} Col John Addison does say that he believes the same is true
& knows that he ever was diligent in discharge of his Duty at
County Courts - Whereupon the Board thought fit to acquit
him from further attendance or Enquire about that Matter -

following Report unto his Ex^{ty} & the Board concerning some
discourse he had with his Ex^{ty} S^r Edmond Andros touching the
College in Virginia, viz^t -
That when the S^r Edmond came over into this Province he went to
pay his respects to him at Maj^r Swalls house where in discourse
he was telling the S^r Edmond that there was no sort of provision
