I (B) do swear that I will well and truly Execute & perform the office of a Surveyor within the County of I will do Right according to my skill and power to all manner of persons, poore & Rich without favour, affection, hatred or Malice to any person or persons whatsoever, I will without delay well and truly Execute all such Warrts & Orders for Surveying and Resurveying Lands within the County afo. as from time to time shall come directed unto me from their Ma^{ties} High Govern^{or} of this Province or any other Authority or Power derived from his Ex^{cy} and make due Return of all Certificates of the Same unto such place or places as by the afo Warrts or Orders I shall be directed, I will increase no fees, nor directly or indirectly Exact, demand, Receive or take any reward off or from any manner of person or persons whatsoever for to doo right or wrong other than the usuall allowed fees appointed for the Surveyors Gen. by the Act of Assembly of this Province, having no regard to other profit or advantage to me or any other person, And lastly I will in all things discharge my Duty in the Office of Surveyor of County afo. to the best of my power, Skill & knowledge so long as I shall continue therein. —
