Came in Philip Clarke made Oath to his Acc^t of Collection of the 1st of the 1st Impost within the District of Potomack and Polomock, that the same is a just & true Acc^t during his time of Officialing that place.

Delivered in at the Board Maj^r Rob^t King his Acc^t of the 1st of the 1st Impost by him collected within the District of Potomack & Polomock Sworn to before his Ex^{cy} the Govern^r in Presence of Thomas Trenchard Esq Edward Randolph Esq two of their Ma^{ty} Hon^{rs} Council and George Layfield Esq their Ma^{ty} Collector of Potomack District, that the same is a just & true Acc^t. —

Ordered that the said severall Officers pay unto his Ex^{cy} the Govern^r the three fourth part of the aforementioned Impost by them collected — Since the arrivall of his Ex^{cy} upon his Ex^{cy} Warrant unto them directed for the same; and that the remaining fourth part be duly applied towards the Maintaining the Magazine with Arms & Ammunition for the defence of this Province — Pursuant to the Saide Ma^{ty} Royall Instructions. —

Came George Plater Esq their Ma^{ty} Receiver Gen^l acknowledge that he had Received according to his Ex^{cy} Ord^r & directions presently after his arrivall in Prills & otherwise to the full value of the fourth part of the 1st of the 1st as by the above three Acc^t adjusted — appears, and had sent to Capt^l Pagan for the severall Armes & ca following pursuant to Ord^r.

At the same time his Ex^{cy} gave order to Mr Plater that not withstanding the Acc^t of the quarter part of the 1st of the 1st this year can not be at present made out & adjusted yet that he should Remitt to Capt^l Pagan as much Money as he finds the same will amount to & likewise gave Order to Mr Clarke to send Bills of Exchange to Mr Plater for the quarter part which this Fleet should come to his hands and further that the said Mr Plater Remitt out of his Ex^{cy} own private Acc^t the sum of 12⁰⁰ sterl^l upon Acc^t for the quarter part of the said 1st of the 1st which is supposed may be collected by Maj^r King Naval Officer of Potomack but the Acc^t thereof & Bills for the same cannot with conveniency be adjusted & sent in this to go with this Fleet, therefore for the use of the Country, disbur^{se} for the said sum, the said Maj^r King last years Acc^t of the quarter part amounting to about that sum, all which said Bills of the quarter part so to be remitted by the said Capt^l Pagan to be disburs^{ed} & paid out
