Know all men by these presents that we Philip Clarke & Robert Mason of the Province of Maryland Gentl, are holden & firmly bound unto his Excellency Francis Nicholson Esq. their Ma. Cap. Gen. & Chief Govern. of this Province in the full & just sum of one thousand pounds of Lawfull Money of England to be paid to the said Francis Nicholson Esq. his Ex. Adm. or Assignee to the which payment well and truly to be made, wee bind ourselvs & either of us by himselfe our & either of our heirs Ex. Adm. jointly & severally for the whole and in the whole firmly by these presents
Witness our hands and Seals November 19th 1694.

The Condition of the above written Obligation is such that Whereas his Excellency Francis Nicholson Esq. hath commissioned and appointed the said Philip Clarke to be Naval Officer, from Point Hook out to Port Tobacco in the River of Potomack in the said Province of Maryland by his Commission bearing equall date with these presents; Now if the said Philip Clarke shall well & truly perform the said Office according to the severall Acts of Parliament in that behalf made and provided, and shall observe the directions contained in the Acts of Assembly of this Province, Relating to the Duty of Naval Officers, & from time to time, save defend and keep harmless the said Francis Nicholson Esq. from all Damage loss & Charge that he the said Francis Nicholson Esq. shall sustain at any time by Reason of the said Philip Clarke's non-performance of his said Office (so long as he shall enjoy the same) as in the said severall Lawes is enacted & Ordained then the above Obligation to be void & of none Effect, otherwise to be & remain in full force & vertue
