that is to say beginning at Fort Tobacco & so by wards to the head of the said
County in the said Province, by his Commission bearing equall date with this
presents, Now if the said Cap^t. Will^m Dent shall well & truly perform
the said Office according to the severall Acts of Parliam^t. in that case made
Provided, & shall observe the Directions contained in the Acts of Assembly
of this Province relating to the Duty of Naval Officers & from time to
time save defend & keep harmless the said Francis Nicholson Esq^r. from
all Damage Loss & Charges that to the said Francis Nicholson Esq^r. shall
