WHEREAS it hath been signified unto me by a Letter reciev'd
from the Hon^{ble}. John Pervey Esq. one of the Clerks of his Ma^{ty}.
Most Hon^{ble}. Privy Councill, our Dep^{ty}. Secretary of his Ma^{ty}.
Plantations bearing date the 9th day of March past how that
his Ma^{ty} hath pleased Almighty God to take unto himself her late
Ma^{ty}. Queen Mary (of ever blessed and glorious Memory) and
of the great and irreparable Loss is thereby sustained
INASMUCH as upon all such Accidents there is a necessity
for the alteration of the Course and Manner of the severall
processes and proceedings had & used in the Respective Courts
I have therefore (by and with the advice of his Ma^{ty}. Hon^{ble}. Councill
thought fit to publish and make known, and I do hereby
accordingly Order & Command that from hence forward
forall all manner of writts, writings, processes, & process
whatsoever Judiciall or otherwise issuing forth of any his Ma^{ty}.
Courts or the Offices within this Province, do beare Title
run in the Name of his Ma^{ty}. King William the third
Willing and Requiring the severall Sheriffs of the Province to
make Proclamation hereof in the most publick & convenient places
within their Respective Counties to w^{ch} all persons therein any wise
concerned are to yeild all ready and due Obedience, as they and
every of them will answer the contrary at their perill given
Under the Great Seal of the Province this 19th day of August, in
the 7th Year of his Ma^{ty}. Reign Annoq^{ue} Domini 1695.

His Ex^{ty} signifying his Receipt of a Lett^{er} from his Ex^{ty} Coll^l Brinj^{er}
Fletcher Governour of New Yorke dated 17th of June last, requiring
that by assistance from this Province of 100 men w^{ch} their proper Officers
towards the Defense of his Ma^{ty}. Province of New York in pursuance of her
Ma^{ty}. Royall Lett^{er} bearing date the 22nd day of August 1694. Whereupon
was ordered to be answered her Ma^{ty}. said Lett^{er} upon perusal whereof there did
