his Ex<sup>r</sup> gent<sup>r</sup> directed, Dated the 23. of July last past touching  
A hundred Raccoon & Fox Skins sent from the Emperor of  
Piscattaway as a present to his Mat<sup>r</sup>. Whereupon his Ex<sup>r</sup> was  
pleased to acquaint the Board that he had Sinc<sup>r</sup> from his said  
Emperor and told him that neither his Mat<sup>r</sup> nor himself require  
any present from him, But gave him to understand that  
His Lord Baltimore must be paid his due and so directed  
Col<sup>r</sup> Addison to redeliver to the said Emperor all His afores-  
mentioned Skins. ◦

Notic<sup>r</sup> of Westmore  
of All Sainte parish in Calvert  
County reporting his Ex-  
premises in a furtherance  
of Mr. Hull preaching among  
the Ord<sup>r</sup> thereon. ◦

Upon Reading the Petition of the veray men of the pish of All  
Saints in Calvert County Setting forth that they had taken care to-  
Build a Church w<sup>i</sup>thin their said parish & had sometime on  
Sundays in an afternoon the Benefit of Mr. Hull preaching  
amongst them; though with difficulty obtained by reason of the  
great distance betwixt his parish Church & theirs; but do hope  
to procure by further assistance, by taking some other Method,  
through his Ex<sup>r</sup> permission, and such as will be no hindrance  
to his own cure; His Ex<sup>r</sup> in Council was pleased to Ord<sup>r</sup> as it is  
hereby Ordered that if in case the said Mr. Hull will take that  
trouble upon him, the prayer of the pet<sup>r</sup> be granted. ◦

His Ex<sup>r</sup> Representacion  
that most of the seafarers  
of the gage of tobacco  
River Huron —

His Ex<sup>r</sup> representing to the Board that several Masters of Ships  
had complained unto him that the Tobacco then now made and  
sent on Board their Ships exceed the Measure prescribes by the  
late Act of Assembly, much to their detriment & damage; —

Ordered that Proclamation issue to give Notice to all Coopers  
and others therin concern<sup>r</sup>, that they make their Casks according  
to<sup>r</sup> Act of Assembly, under penalty of being proceeded against  
according to Law, wherein directing all Casks to be measured  
when they come on Board. ◦

Signed by his Ex<sup>r</sup> & passed the Broad Seal of the Province,

Proclamation touching

Whiles Complaint hath been made by Divers Owners and  
Masters of Ships Trading into this Province how that several  
Merchant & other Inhabitants w<sup>i</sup>thin the same doe notwithstanding  
a late Act of Assembly passed the 10<sup>th</sup> day of October 1694  
entituled an Act touching Coopers & the Gage of Tobacco herte, continue  
to make & cause to be made of their Tobacco herte, care exceeding  
the Measure being in the said Act prescribed & set downe, Lund
