

Penalty of Seizure of all such goods Wares & Merchandizes so as if -  
 imported and sold contrary to the intent & meaning aforesaid,  
 And Further that all such Boats, Shallops, Sloops, or other  
 Vessels, or any Land carriage, whatsoever that for the future are  
 or shall be transported out of Pennsylvania Town of New castle  
 & Territory, and into this Province over Land that the owners  
 Masters or Employers of the same Give the Navall Officer of  
 Cecil County an Act. thereof and take his permit to go to one or  
 both of the aforesaid Ports under like penalty of Seizure  
 and of being proceeded agt. according to Law hereby strictly  
 Enjoyning and Comanding all & singular, by Ma<sup>r</sup>. Collectors in  
 this Province their Deputies & others whom it doth or may concern  
 to make diligent Search both by Land & Water for all such goods  
 Wares and Merchandizes not legally imported and the same to  
 seize & cause them to be proceeded agt. according to due course  
 of Law, And to the end all diligent care may be taken to prevent  
 the inticing a way to amon others it is hereby provided that  
 if in case any such person inticed shall be found on board of  
 Board on Board any Boat, Shallop, Sloop or other Vessel belonging  
 to the Province of Pennsylvania Town of New castle & Territory,  
 thereunto belonging, such Boat Shallop Sloop or Vessel shall in  
 like manner be liable to be seized & proceeded agt. And  
 to the end due notice thereof may be given I do hereby Comand  
 the severall Sheriffs of the provinces to make Proclamation  
 thereof in the most publick & convenient places within their  
 respective Counties. Willing and Acquiring all Officers and  
 others whom this doth or may concern to give all due Obedience  
 therunto at their will Given at the Court of Annapolis under  
 the great Seal of the provinces this 15<sup>th</sup> day of August in the  
 Seventh Year of his Ma<sup>r</sup>. Reign Annoq. Domij. 1695. Or

Ordered that what Arms were by any person taken away from Mattapani  
 in the time of the Revolution the same be Restored again either to the  
 Owner (if to be found) or Colonel of the County, where the present possessors  
 of such Arms live, and on penalty of being proceeded agt. And that the  
 Sheriffs of Sub. Mary, Talbot, & Charles Counties, making inquiry  
 thereabout give Notice thereof in alleports within their respective  
 Counties & make Return of their proceedings therein unto the Board  
 with all convenient speed
