John Davis, Paul Pugel &c. Howell Butcher seamen
belonging to the Merchant of London whereof Capt' Nicholas
Humphries Commander Complaining that they were
Shipt at Plymouth for this Country & back again and that
the said Captain Humphries, besides Maintaining them in their
allowance threatening to pay them nothing of the Bottle
& that if it cost him five hundred pounds.....they shall
not have any wages at their Return & leaving Relief
therew.

The said Petition was read & duly Considered & the Petition
& the said Captain Humphries & their Engagements Alleged
and heard & upon the same being fully heard & nothing
Appearing to Vify or make good their complaint in the
Petition set forth but rather on the contrary the said Captain
Humphries offering at this Board to pay their Wages duly
on performance of their Duty & affirming that they had
full allowance of provisions &c

Ordered that the said Petitioners return to the said
Ship & perform their duty for which they were Shipped &
Engaged
