

That the sum of the subsidies be now put in his  
officer for the same year & given to Provost & the  
King further to the disturbance of the government until

Wherein And that it is also Represented by his Majestys  
Council of this Province that a Church Government being  
settled & established here & also a Protestant Government  
the ill consequences that will happen if once the said Bal-  
timore should be restored to the Government as formerly  
besides the Great Mischief that would consequently ensue  
to all his Majestys good Subjects in General here residing  
by the Altering the good Frame and Constitutions of several  
Courts of Judicature Viz that of the Governor and Council  
for having opposite &c the County the provincial &  
Commissioner Courts & the several County Courts beside the  
Danger of anent being put to all those considerable Actions  
depending in the several Courts here wherein his Sa-  
cred Majesty is more immediately Interested and that it  
be further Represented the great Encouragement that will be  
given to the Irish Jesuits priests & others of that party to  
& flock hither as before was usual in the said Baltimore  
from to the very great Discouragement of the English In-  
habitants & hindrance of the progress of the Protestant  
Religion within this his Majestys Province
