Article Such Persons as have been Disaffected to the King & Government he puts into the Office of the Govt

To this Article the said Mr Clark made Answer in Writing as follows viz

As to the tenth Article viz Such Persons as have been Disaffected with his Majestys Government he puts into Offices of the Government This Deponent saith that as for St Marys County where he dwells according to the Antient Division he knows of no Protestant that had not been Profactory in the time of the late Revolution save one Captain Henry Smith as to other parts of this Province this Deponent knows nothing of his own knowledge therefore Refers to the Records & Proceedings of those times which Doubtless will shew who was Disaffected who not.
