Ordered that John Markwood one of the Clerks of Poughkeeps County be discharged from his said Office for Charging & receiving of Fees contrary to Law by the presentment of the Grand Jury of the Provincial Court appears & that a blank Commission be sent over to Coll<sup>l</sup> Charles Hutchins to insert some other Capable Person as he shall think fit in his Stead

Ordered that the presentment of the Grand Jury of the Justices of Suffolk County be delivered to the Majesty's Lawyers to Prosecute

And that the presentments of the Commissioners of Calvert & S<sup>t</sup> Marys County be examined by the Records whether they be not allowed more than they Ought

Ordered that the Clerks of S<sup>t</sup> Marys & Calvert Counties do upon Sight hereof return unto his Excellency at the Court of Annapolis an exact Acc<sup>t</sup> under their respective hands to be shown to in open Court of the Number of days each particular Commissioner has sat in Court from the time of the laying their County Levy in the year 1696 until the laying the Levy this last Year & that the respective Ordinary Keepers where any of the Comms<sup>s</sup> have been charged Expenses upon the Score of their attendance on Courts, <sup>do also</sup> send the particulars of those Expenses under their respective Hands to commence the said Acc<sup>t</sup> from the time afove mentioned & to be continued to the Laying the Levy also the Last Year which said Acc<sup>t</sup> are to be likewise Sworn to by the said Respective Ordinary Keepers in
