His Excellency is pleased likewise to give & utter
to the said ^{People} Town every Sunday a Mutton & as much
Indian Corn as will Amount to Thirteen Shillings of
Wick & orders Mr Synes to Comitt Captain Keitch in
Order to provide the same & his Excellency will pay them
for it

Ordered that the person that reads prayers at the
Cool Spring take an Acc^t of what persons come thither
who are cured & of what Distempers paper being sent
him by the said Mr Synes

Ordered that the several Officers provide good
Differing Locks to their Offices in the State house
