that some remonstrance be made to their Lordships the
right honble the Lord of the Council of Trade & plantations
that an issue may be taken & directed to you for the
settling this matter of customs law for want whereof so
evil consequence may grow to the disturbance of
this his Majestys plantation & especially in regard that the
measures now used by his Lordship will give in settling
such what appears here without any ingesta
found therein to settling but additio[n]al sum to the
unthinking people that purchase the same & have no
thing but his Lordships Right Honourable

of August 1698 giving an account of his Majestys pleasure
to whom he is to Virginia
