that every first Officers have paid the impositions by Act of
Assembly laid upon their respective Offices

Ordered therefore that the several Sheriffs return
an Acc^t to the said Treasurers of who have & who have
not paid & that the said Treasurers upon their refusal
to comply therewith acquaint his Majesty's Atty General
who is hereby ordered to prosecute them

Ordered that the several Clerks of the respective
Counties return a list of what Officers are in their said
County who ought to pay the said Impositions

Ordered that Mr Sly Clark & Masons fines
amounting to the sum of 10000 li of Tobacco be by the
Committee for History the publick Revenue appropria
ted for payment of those persons who had great trouble
given them by these means & that Mr Atty General
make Report what charge said Clark Sly & Masons ought
to pay & the rest of the Tobacco to be divided proportiona
bly & paid by whom it appears to be due

Ordered that Mr Atty General make Report whether
they shall please that he may marry people without
their Banns published or Licence Granted & whether
such persons are not obliged to register their Births Mar
riages & Burials & according to the Act of Assembly

Whereas there is the last Assembly Enacted a Law
