Whereas by the publick Procurers Act it appears
that very few Officers have paid the impositions by Act of
Assembly laid upon their respective Officers

Ordered therefore that the several Sheriffs return
an account to the said Sheriffs of who have & who have
not paid & that the said Sheriffs upon their refusal
to comply therewith require his Majestys Alm General
who is hereby ordered to prosecute them

Ordered that the several Clerks of the respective
Counties return a list of what Officers are in their said
County notwithstanding to pay the said impositions

Ordered that Mr Ely Clark & Masons fines
amounting to the sum of 10000 £ of Tobacco be by the
Committee for Rating the publick Revenue appropriated
for payment of those persons who had great trouble
given them by their names & that Mr Alm General
make his selfe charge with Clark Ely & Masons
to pay to the rest of the Tobacco to be divided proportiona-
lly & paid by whom it appears to be due

Ordered that Mr Alm General make Report whether
any such plumb markers may many people without
their Births published on License Granted & whether
such persons are not obliged to register their Births Mar-
riages & Deaths & according to the Act of Assembly
